Chairman Zwirn called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance. Commissioner McLavey moved to waive the reading of the minutes and approve them as written for the January 22, 2008 meeting. Chairman Zwirn seconded and the motion carried 2-0.

Under unfinished business Commissioner Meisner moved for the approval of an agreement between Logan County and Kenneth Gareis for use of the county right-of-way along CR 36 for an underground pipeline. Commissioner McLavey seconded and the motion carried 3-0.

Under new business Commissioner McLavey moved to table the CVB Development for the Logan County Lodging Tax Board Project. Commissioner Meisner seconded and the motion carried 3-0.

Chairman Zwirn stated the Logan County Tax Board Project for 2005 NCTR Mileage Reimbursement has been withdrawn from the agenda.

Commissioner Meisner moved for the acknowledgment of the receipt of the Veteran's Service Officer's Report for the month December 2007. Commissioner McLavey seconded and the motion carried 3-0.

Inspection of the Logan County Jail was conducted Friday, February 1, 2008 at 8:00 a.m. There are currently the following number of inmates: 74 in-county males, 12 in-county females, 0 out-of-county males, 0 out-of-county females, 21 Federal males, 3 Federal females, 0 work release males, 0 work release females and 0 DOC inmates. This is a total of 110 inmates with 95 being males and 15 females.

Miscellaneous Business/Announcements:

Chairman Zwirn stated that the Logan County Commissioners Offices and the Logan County Finance Office will be moving to the new office space on the second floor of the old Courthouse beginning today. The move will be completed on January 30, 2008. Any person having business with the Commissioners Office and Finance Office should be aware of this and plan accordingly. The Planning and Zoning Office and the Assessor's Office will remain at the Courthouse Annex until their office space in the old Courthouse is completed this year.
